Shalom,

Over the years, when I have talked about spiritual things with local Jewish people they have asked me, "What synagogue do you attend?" When I answer "Congregation Shema Yisrael," they almost always say, "I've never heard of that synagogue." That answer has been helpful because I usually get to share that it is a Messianic Jewish synagogue where we believe that Yeshua is the Messiah. But that answer has also been very discouraging because it means



that 34 years after Congregation Shema Yisrael's founding, most of the people we are trying to reach still don't even know we exist, much less what we believe or what we have to offer. We are invisible to them, even though we have put on many outreach events, advertised, have an online presence and use social media.

Therefore, I am very pleased to be able to share with you the direction the Ruach Ha Kodesh (Holy Spirit) has been leading Congregation Shema Yisrael over the past few years. He has opened a door of opportunity for us to purchase a beautiful facility whose location will make us very visible to the Jewish community of the Greater Rochester area. That facility is located in Brighton NY, very near the Jewish Community Center (JCC) and on the most frequently used street leading to the JCC.

This facility will greatly enhance our ability to fulfill the purpose of Congregation Shema Yisrael, which is to effectively reach the Jewish people of the Greater Rochester area with the Good News of Yeshua (Jesus) and disciple them. The increased visibility will also enhance our ability to effectively reach and disciple non-Jewish people by connecting them with the Jewish Roots of their faith and restoring a Biblical understanding of God's plan for Israel and our relationship to the Laws of Moses..

We believe reaching and discipling the Jewish people of this area is vitally important:

- 1. Because Jewish people, like all people, need to hear the Good News effectively presented and have an opportunity to enter the Kingdom of God.
- 2. Because Yeshua said, speaking to the Jewish people in Jerusalem just before His crucifixion, "For I tell you, from now on, you will not see me again until you say, 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of ADONAI (the LORD).'" (Matthew 23:39). We understand Him to mean He will not return until the Jewish people welcome Him.

Please read this brochure carefully and prayerfully. As you do, simply ask the Lord, "What do You want to do through me to accomplish Your will for Congregation Shema Yisrael?" If you pray this prayer and do what God leads you to do in faith, our capital campaign, *For Such a Time as This*, will succeed in raising the money we need to purchase this facility.

Please pray for us to be able to walk with the Lord through this awesome open door! Please also pray for the successful sale of our building, as we will be selling our current facility on Winton Road to raise part of the money to purchase the facility on Edgewood Ave. by the end of 2020.

HOW SHEMA YISRAEL CAME TO BE

Our congregation was established by Jonathan Bernis in 1984 and and was blessed to be able to meet in a downtown church for four years. In 1988, we took a major step of faith and bought and renovated our current facility on North Winton Road. We have been greatly blessed to have this facility as our home for 30 years. Many people, both Jewish and Gentile, have found the Lord here, been set free from bondage, connected with their Jewish Roots, received a Biblical understanding of God's plan for Israel and gained an understanding of our relationship to the Laws of Moses. Significant events have also taken place here and many outreaches have been launched from here including Sharing Our Bread, our Russian Outreach, Holiday Celebrations, Aleph Clubs, Fishing Outreach Trips, the Chanukah Light Show, the Annual March of Remembrance, Bridge Bags and our Public Market Outreach.

WHAT IS LACKING: REASON FOR THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

- Lack of visibility to the local Jewish community. Because our present location is well outside of the local Jewish community, most Jewish people are unaware of our existence. Having a facility visible to the Jewish community would make us more effective.
- Lack of alternatives for the "spiritually seeking" Jewish people. Many of the 25,000 Jewish people in the Greater Rochester area are "spiritually seeking," especially among Intermarried Couples and adult children of Intermarried Couples. Congregation Shema Yisrael can provide an alternative for them but, because of our current location, they are unaware of our existence.
- Lack of accessibility for Jewish believers. Jewish people who have come
 to believe that Yeshua is the Messiah are unaware of Shema Yisrael's
 existence and that we are a place where they can follow Yeshua without
 having to lose their Jewish identity, enabling them to more effectively
 reach family and friends with the Good News.

ABOUT THE EFMC BUILDING


In addition to the benefit of being in a location where many Jewish people will pass by our sign, we will gain several significant improvements by purchasing the EFMC facility.

- An air-conditioned sanctuary that is twice the size of our current one.
- A large lobby for before and after-service fellowship.
- A 50% larger fellowship hall that seats 100 people
- A well equipped, modern kitchen
- Office space sufficient for our expanding needs
- A large parking lot
- A new HVAC system that will reduce utilities costs
- Modern plumbing and electrical systems which will reduce maintenance costs
- Lots of classrooms and a playground.

The EFMC facility opens up several new possibilities for growth of our ministries.

- 1. There are apartment complexes in the neighborhood with many single parent families whom we can help with our Sharing Our Bread grocery distribution ministry.
- 2. The facility would be ideal for a Day Care and/or Pre-School.
- 3. The EFMC facility is the ideal location for a Messianic Jewish Synagogue in the Greater Rochester area. We believe that thousands of Jewish people will become aware of the existence and location of our congregation and what we have to offer.
- 4. Local Jewish seekers will become aware they can learn about the Bible and Messiah in a culturally Jewish friendly setting.

All this will result in revival in the Jewish community of Greater Rochester.



FUNDRAISING INFORMATION AND GOALS

HOW TO PARTICIPATE



Give a one-time up-front gift.

Ask God what He would have you contribute.



Make a weekly or monthly pledge.

By spreading out your giving over a 2 year period, you can contribute far more than you thought was possible.



Give stocks, securities or assets.

A creative way to participate is by donating stocks, securities or assets.



Consider sacrificial giving.

This is not giving recklessly or presumptuously without attention to the reality of one's financial circumstances. Sacrificial giving means to sacrifice something you are paying for now, in order to be able to financially support what the Lord has put on your heart.

For example, giving up Cable TV should save about \$120 per month. That's \$2900 over 2 years. Giving up going out to lunch once per week for a couple would save \$3600 over 2 years. Other ways of sacrificially giving could involve finding additional work to do, or selling some things you don't need anymore.

YOU HAVE QUESTIONS? WE HAVE ANSWERS

Should I redirect my tithe or regular giving to the *For Such a Time as This* campaign?

No. Your giving commitment to the campaign should be above and beyond your regular giving. Your tithe and regular giving are used to support the current programs and ministries of Congregation Shema Yisrael.

How do I make my commitment to the **For Such a Time as This** campaign?

During the launch of the campaign, we will come together as a family to participate with God in this exciting move.

We will have an opportunity to:

- Complete a commitment card to indicate what God is leading us to give, over and above our regular giving, for the next three years.
- Give our First Fruits Offering our largest possible gift that counts toward that commitment. First fruit offerings & commitment cards can be turned in before or after that weekend in case you're unable to attend one of the services.

What is a First Fruits Offering?

A First Fruit offering is a way of worshipping God by giving a portion of what God has given to us for supporting His work on earth.

Is my commitment confidential?

All giving to Congregation Shema Yisrael is completely confidential, including giving to the *For Such a Time as This* campaign.

Can my commitment be changed if necessary?

Commitments can be changed if necessary, allowing you to either increase or decrease your commitment as needed. Your decision to change your commitment should be done only after much prayer.

Will I be billed monthly for my pledge?

No. We will be counting on you to meet your commitments in a timely manner. If giving via check, please be sure to designate your checks by writing 'FOR SUCH A TIME' on the memo line.

What are donor advised funds?

These are all types of assets (cash, stocks, non-liquid assets). You can setup a Giving Fund through National Christian Foundation and choose Congregation Shema Yisrael as the recipient of these assets and receive an income tax deduction at the time of the donation.
